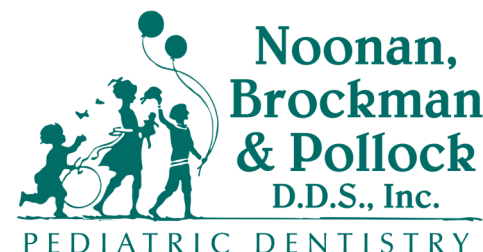

**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

Any artist between the ages of 13 and 18 years of age and must be Jr/ Sr. high school is eligible to submit art work. Only works in (1) oils or acrylics, (2) watercolor (3) drawing (including pastels and inks), (4) mixed media (a combination of the above only) (5) photography & (6) digital art (computer-generated artwork or artwork captured digitally and heavily collaged or manipulated to produce a new image. More than one category may be entered. All works must be original and never exhibited previously in a juried exhibit at the Middletown Arts Center.

**ENTRY FEE:**

There will be a \$3 non-refundable fee per entry. There is no limit to the number of entries; however, a maximum of 3 pieces per artist, per category will be displayed. Cash or Check. Please make checks payable to the Middletown Arts Center.

**RECEIVING AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

All entries must be delivered to the Middletown Arts Center, 130 N. Verity Pkwy, Middletown, OH during the following times:  
**January 21, 22, 23—10:00 - 8:00 p.m.**

No entries will be accepted other than times and dates listed. Artwork must be matted, framed, and wired for hanging or artwork must be permanently adhered to the mat. **(clips will be used for hanging from the edge of the mat). Size Limitation of finished piece should be no larger than 22" x 26" including frame.**

**All pieces that are accepted in the exhibit may not be removed until after March 12 at 5:00 p.m.**

**SALES:**

The sale of art work to the public is encouraged. A commission of 30% will be retained for any work sold as a result of the show and work should be priced to include the commission. If for sale, forms must be filled out with Artist home address, not school address. If the work is not for sale, please indicate by marking "NFS"

**NO TAPE OF ANY KIND IS TO BE USED.**

Unsuitable presentation will be grounds for non-acceptance. *Forms must be filled out correctly and completed at time of entry.* Early registration forms for schools available upon request by teachers only. Would need teacher's name, school, school address and how many forms needed. One form per picture is needed.

**NOTIFICATION AND RETURN OF WORK:**

Notification of acceptance into the show will be posted on the MAC web site by January 25th. Work not accepted may be picked up after February 3. Accepted entries may not be removed from the exhibit before 5 p.m. **March 12, 2020. All work not claimed 6 months from close of exhibit becomes the property of the Middletown Arts Center.**

There must be 8 accepted pieces in a category to be judged for 1st, 2nd, 3rd in a category for awards. The final decision, in all cases, rests with the judge. The judge **may** award an Honorable Mention in those categories if they choose to. All awards will be presented during the opening reception on Saturday, February 1, 11a.m.. Artist should be present or attend the exhibit to receive their award.

**EXHIBITION AND OPENING**

**RECEPTION:**

Tomorrow's Artists Today will be open to the public from February 1 at 10 a.m.. through March 12 at 5:00 p.m. during regular building hours. The opening reception for the exhibition and awards presentation will be held Saturday, February 1, 10 - Noon in the Center's Exhibit Hall. Awards will be presented at 11:00 am. All participants are encouraged to attend. ***Artist should be present at opening or attend the exhibit to receive their award. In case of inclement weather please call the art center for notice of cancellation of opening.***

**LIABILITY:**

All reasonable care will be taken in handling work submitted; however, the Middletown Arts Center, the judge, nor the committee will not be held responsible for loss or damage to works of art. All works are entered at the artist's risk, and the artist must provide his/her own insurance.

Submission of work to this exhibition shall be understood to indicate an agreement on the part of the artist with conditions set forth. This includes the artist's permission to have photographs of their work used for publicity and for promotion without compensation.
